

AMENDMENT
OFFERED BY MR. STUPAK OF MICHIGAN AND MR.
INSLEE OF WASHINGTON

At the end of the bill, add the following new section
(and conform the table of contents accordingly):

1 SEC. 13. FEDERAL FLEET FUELING CENTERS.

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than January 1, 2010,
3 the head of each Federal agency shall install at least 1
4 renewable fuel pump at each Federal fleet fueling center
5 in the United States under the jurisdiction of the head
6 of the Federal agency.

7 (b) REPORT.—Not later than October 31 of the first
8 calendar year beginning after the date of the enactment
9 of this Act, and each October 31 thereafter, the President
10 shall submit to Congress a report that describes the
11 progress toward complying with subsection (a), including
12 identifying—

13 (1) the number of Federal fleet fueling centers
14 that contain at least 1 renewable fuel pump; and

15 (2) the number of Federal fleet fueling centers
16 that do not contain any renewable fuel pumps.

1 (c) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
2 are authorized to be appropriated such sums as are nec-
3 essary to carry out this section.
